2. Primary 1 Registration for 2025

We are happy to provide you with an update on the successful completion of the Primary 1 Registration Exercise for the upcoming academic year 2025. The school had 240 vacancies for the Primary 1 cohort of 2025 and all places were filled up. We look forward to welcoming our new students in 2025!

3. PSLE Listening Comprehension and Written Examinations

As our Primary 6 students will be taking their PSLE (Listening Comprehension) on **13 September**, Primary 1 to 5 students will <u>not</u> report to school on that day. Home-based learning (HBL) assignments will be assigned. More information will be made available on the school website at a later date. The Primary 6 students will also be taking their PSLE Written Examinations from **26 September to 2 October**. Lessons for Primary 1 to 5 students will carry on as usual. Your child/ward will be required to report to school on those days.

4. Primary 6 Study Break

There will be a 3-day study break for all Primary 6 students from **23 to 25 September**. During the break, Primary 6 students are strongly encouraged to remain at home and do their revision. The school will remain open for students identified to receive support from teachers. Students who require assistance from their teachers may arrange for consultations with their teachers. The Student Care Centre in the school will operate only from 1.30 p.m. during the study break. Lessons will carry on as usual for Primary 1 to 5 students.
