Dear Parents/Guardians,

1. Attendance and Punctuality

As we move into Term 2, we have observed that our students have become more familiar with the school and classroom routines. We are happy to welcome our students to a new term. Together, let us continue to encourage them to attend school regularly as every school day offers new learning. Punctuality is a crucial life skill we want to imbue in our students, too. Being on time helps them to be calm and ready for lessons. Our teachers take daily attendance and late-coming will be noted as part of a student's behavioural record. Please continue to help your child/ward cultivate the good habit of reporting to school punctually.

2. Students' Safety

After-school Activities

Students with after-school activities are **not allowed** to leave the school compound during lunchtime from **1.30 p.m. to 2.00 p.m.** They are to have lunch and wait in the school premises for their after-school activities to start. This will allow the school to account for their whereabouts in case of emergencies. Please be assured that the canteen vendors will prepare sufficient food and drinks for students to purchase for lunch. We urge all parents/guardians to remind your children/wards to remain in the school as they await the start of their after-school activities.

Safe Play

At the recent termly assembly talk, our students were reminded to play safely during their break times in school. They should not push or pull one another during play. In the event of injuries or emergencies, they should approach any teacher nearby for help. Alternatively, they could proceed to the General Office for assistance.

3. Attendance & Temperature- Taking Exercise (ATTEx)

The ATTEx for 2026 will be conducted in Term 2 Week 2, on **Wednesday, 1 April**. This exercise aims to:

1. ensure that the school remains prepared to reactivate the attendance- and temperature-taking regime if needed, and
2. educate students to be responsible for their own health and practise social responsibility.

4. International Friendship Day and Hari Raya Celebrations 2026

The school will celebrate Hari Raya Puasa alongside the commemoration of International Friendship Day this term with the theme, 'Global Raya - Appreciating Cultures and Perspectives in this Complex World'. A special interactive assembly programme will take place on **Friday, 10 April**. It will be split into 4 segments - Part 1 and 2: Foundations of Friendship; Part 3 and 4: Global Perspectives; Part 5: United in Every Colour. There will also be exciting activities during recess for students to gain a better understanding of friendship and the customs and traditions of various countries in Asia. By focussing on the importance of friendship and staying connected with our neighbouring countries, we hope to inspire

our students to play a more active role in fostering people-to-people ties.

The school will also be hosting the ‘My Little Chingay Float’ Education Truck on **Friday, 17 April** from 8.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. in line with the International Friendship Day commemoration. Students will get a chance to interact with the various interactive elements of the truck to learn more about the vibrancy, diversity, and creative spirit of the Chingay Parade in a fun and accessible way. They will be able to do so during the recess and lunch breaks on that day.

Our Primary 6 students will be taking the NAPFA Test consisting of five stations, on **Wednesday, 8 April** and **Wednesday, 15 April**. P6 students taking part in SYF will take their tests in May.
