






Objectives

WHY CCA?


- CCA places emphasis on:







FREQUENTLY asked questions

OUECTION	ANIOWED
QUESTION	ANSWER
Can my child in Niche CCA quit his CCA in P3 & P4?	If he/she quits, he/she must select a non-niche CCA that has a vacancy
Can my child in a Niche CCA have 2 Niche CCAs? Eg Basketball & Track or Track & Dance	No. The training sessions for the niche CCAs are on the same day for both the Friday CCA & additional training days
Can my child in P3 or P4 join a Niche CCA?	Yes, but he/she must undergo the trials to ascertain the skill level to see if he/she is on the same level of fitness and skills as his/her peers in that CCA.
Must he/she quit his/her other CCA to join the niche CCA if selected	Yes
Can my child have 2 non niche CCAs?	No. All CCAs are conducted on Fridays.
How often my child can change his/her CCA?	Child must remain in the CCA for a year. Change is allowed at the end of P3 & P4 but not at P5 & P6. Change of CCA requires outgoing CCA & incoming CCA teachers' approval and reasons for change. Parents' approval is required. Please note a change of CCA is allowed ONLY if there is a vacancy. Students will be on waiting list if there is no vacancy.








Dear Parents/Guardians of P2 girls,
