Dear Parents,

Ready, Set, Go!



We start off 2019 with a warm welcome to our new Vice Principal, Mr Khoo Ghee Han! We look forward to a new year of learning and growing together as a team.

Just before the new year, our teachers had the privilege to be addressed by Mr Lai Chin Kwang, Chief, ActiveSG, at our annual Learning Symposium with Raffles Girls Primary School and Marymount Convent School. We learnt from him that we are never too old to acquire knowledge, never too old to take on different roles and never too old to add value to our work. To him, nothing beats the motivation that comes from within, especially when one says, "I want to try." We can identify with Mr Lai as we always encourage our students to say "I want to try" through the varied learning opportunities in Kheng Cheng School. We believe that parents play an important role too as part of the home-school partnership and we look forward to share our initiatives with you through our monthly memos and various engagement sessions.

School Hours, Punctuality & Snack Time

We have implemented the revised school hours for a year. As most days end at 1.45 pm, the snack time at 11.50 am is important so that our students would continue to be energized. Do pack a healthy snack for them or encourage them to buy a snack from the school canteen before school or during recess. School starts at 7.30 am and we encourage students to come early so that they can participate in our daily preassembly programmes such as story-telling, community singing, calisthenics and informative talks. Punctuality is a crucial life skill we want to imbue in our students. Our teachers take daily attendance and late coming will be noted as part of the student's behaviour records.

Safety and Security in School

Our students' safety is of paramount importance. Students will be dismissed according to the written instructions provided by parents. Please give your child clear instructions on where you will pick him/her up after school. Staff will also be deployed at the front gate during peak hours to ensure students' safety. As the school is undergoing upgrading works, we would like to ask parents to ensure that their child would not stay back after school for unsupervised activities. In addition, visitors and parents would not be allowed to loiter in school premises. All visitors and parents would be required to register with the guard at the front gate before reporting to the general office.

Students' Well-Being & Temperature Taking

We expect our students to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene. If your child is unwell, do consult a doctor and let him/her rest at home. Our teachers will carry out daily visual checks and will contact

parents to bring unwell students home/to seek medical attention. Keep the form teacher updated and submit the medical certificate when he/she is fit to return. The school will be conducting a temperature taking exercise on *Mon, 7 Jan*. Please ensure that your child has his/her thermometer and that it is in good working condition¹. Replacement ODTs can be purchased from the school bookshop.

Remedial, Supplementary & Enrichment Classes

To complement the existing school curriculum and to provide a varied learning experience, the school will schedule enrichment courses for our students. Students may need to pay for these enrichment courses using their Edusave funds and/or cash. Additionally, students who need support in their learning will be identified accordingly for remedial (P1-4) and supplementary (P5-6) classes. The Form Teachers will inform you via a memo if your child is attending any of these programmes. If there are changes to the regular schedules, the teachers will inform you and your child in writing. Please keep all memos and consent forms so as to ensure your child return home safely. *Do communicate additional after-school activities and transport arrangements you have made, clearly to your child and caregivers.*

Parents Gateway (PG) is a mobile app to update parents and perform administrative functions (such as publishing Announcements and requesting consent via Consent Forms). The school is currently working with MOE on the rollout of PG for the school. We will notify parents via the school website and monthly memo when we are ready with PG. Parents do not have to download PG until then.

Conclusion

This year, we will also celebrate Singapore's bicentennial since Sir Stamford Raffles landing in 1819. Kheng Cheng School; a school by the community and for the community, will be 92. We have come thus far and will to continue to live the values our founder had espoused. The school rounded off a good 2018 with a celebration of our students' achievements in their PSLE, especially in 10 point increase in the mean PSLE score. We have done well in many areas, and are proud of every single one of our students.
